

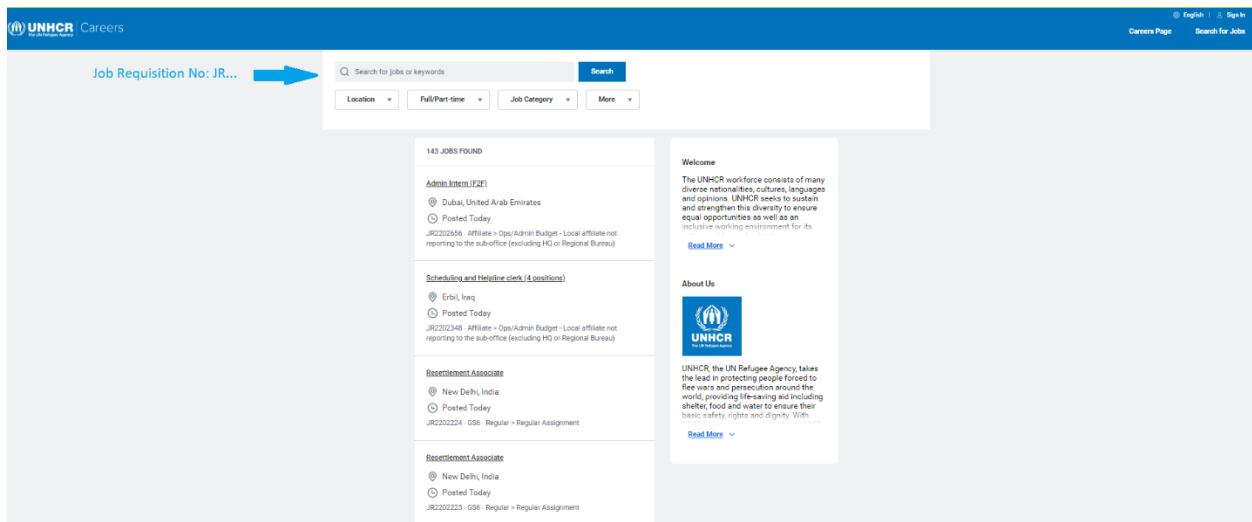

Candidate Home



- Tasks may be routed to candidate home for candidate completion, such as:
 - Questionnaires
 - Additional personal information collection
 - Document review (offer letters/employment agreements)
- Candidates with an account can:
 - Dynamically use last application to prefill additional applications
 - Check the status of submitted applications
 - Save for later (automatically saved after My Information page is reached)
 - Withdraw application(s)
